Frank and Shawn spent their first 10 years of this ministry living and working among the many people groups of Nigeria, West Africa, with projects reaching into Togo, Benin and Kenya. Their youngest son Nathanael, was able to graduate from Corunna High School while the family was on furlough.

Now, in a partnership with Wycliffe Bible Translators and Faith Comes By Hearing, Frank and Shawn continue to record the Bible in other languages and train foreign recording teams wherever the need arises. Since the start of their partnership with Faith Comes By Hearing, they have recorded Bible portions for the Pitjantjatjara, an Aboriginal people of Australia, in the Chaldean language, a Chinese minority language recorded in Hong Kong, the Garhwali people of Northern India, and in the Armenian language. Their passion is to see the glory of God made known everywhere by making His Word available to all people, in the language that best speaks to their hearts and in a form and manner that best suits their needs.
